

Wednesday Snow Sports Program SR 17-18

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<u>The program starts</u> Wednesday, January 10, 2018 at Summit Central Ski Area and continues for six consecutive weeks finishing on February 14, unless weather forces postponement. If a cancellation occurs, we automatically extend the program the number of trips missed.

<u>The bus loads</u> at school at 1:15 P M and returns at approximately 6:30 P M in the evening. Registration is limited to the first 35 applicants. Adult chaperones will be on the bus. **This program is for second through fifth grade.**

Classes begin at 2:30 P M and are 2 1/2 hours long. Lessons are taught by SSCS with thirty five years of teaching experience in the greater Seattle area.

<u>To enroll</u> mail this registration form and tuition directly to SSCS 204 165th Ave SE Bellevue, 98008-4726. Please do not hand deliver to this address. Enrollment is secured on a first come, first served basis, and registration must be accompanied with payment to secure your space. Seasons passes and ski rentals are not included with this tuition. Registration deadline is Tuesday, November 14, 2017.

<u>To receive</u> a discounted seasons pass (which is required for all students) sign up for this program. Season Pass information will be emailed to you once SSCS has received your tuition and registration form. Please be aware passes are purchased through the Summit @ Snoqualmie <u>ONLY!</u> SSCS will not be responsible for your passes. Direction for buying passes are enclosed with this registration form.

Deadline for ordering passes is Friday, December 15, 2017.
