- Membership fees are non-refundable
- Full payment is due 2 weeks prior to a program's start date. If payment is not received, registration will be cancelled
- No refunds will be given if registration is cancelled once the program has started
- There is a \$25 returned payment fee.

Played indoors on a hard court surface, Futsal is making a five-a-side game where technique, craftiness and speedy decision-making matters. The futsal ball is a low bounce ball that forces players to play the ball on the ground more than in the air. The emphasis on possession helps players develop great passing skill and vision that translates directly to outdoor soccer. Each instructor has earned the Level 1 Futsal Diploma from the United Soccer Coaches Association (formerly the National Soccer Coaches Association of America). Members are supervised by professional staff who serve as positive role models, all in a caring, safe place. Project Learn Times & Locations

This program runs through mid-June. The Club is open Monday thru Friday, directly after school release until 6:30 PM. Scholarships & payment plans are available.

Open enrollment for the 2019 - 2020 school year will begin on Monday, April 29th at 9:00 AM.

Main Club will service students from Clyde Hill, Enatai, Medina, Bellevue Christian, Puesta del Sol and Jing Mei Elementary schools. We also have Clubs in Bennett, Cherry Crest, Jing Mei and Phantom Lake Elementary schools, the Eastside Terrace, Hidden Village and Spiritwood Housing Complexes and at the Crossroads and South Bellevue Community Centers. The South Bellevue Community Center serves children from Cougar Ridge, Eastgate, Newport Heights, Puesta del Sol, Spiritridge and Somerset Elementary Schools.
