RECOMMENDED STEPS FOR A FUN SCIENCE FAIR:

1. Think of a super cool science topic you love. Ask your teacher, friends, or family for ideas, or look in books or online!
2. Ask a big question you want to answer with your science project.
3. Make a smart guess (hypothesis) about what you think will happen.
4. Plan your science test and get all the materials you need.
5. Do your science test and follow the steps you planned.
6. Watch carefully and write down what happens.
7. See if what you wrote down matches your guess.
8. Show what you learned on a tri-fold board. You can also use a cardboard box to make it a stand-up display.
9. Make sure to include a Big Title, List of Stuff (Materials), Step-by-Step How-To (Methods), What You Found (Findings), and The Big Answer (Conclusion).
10. Decorate with cool pictures or drawings to make it extra awesome!



RULES FOR PARTICIPATING IN THE SCIENCE FAIR

1. Kindergarten and first graders are encouraged to do group projects.
2. Second and Third graders can do individual or group projects.
3. Fourth and fifth graders are encouraged to do individual projects.
4. **ONLY** 4th and 5th grade projects will be evaluated and judged.
5. No water, fire or electricity (plug-ins) allowed at the science fair.
6. Experiments needing water, fire or electricity can be pre-recorded at home and demonstrated at the fair via laptop or iPad video.
