Cut out the Label UPC code or Box Top to put on a collection form or in an envelope with your teacher’s name on it. Then turn them in to your teacher or drop off in the container at the school office by ***Tuesday, February 28, 2017.***

The class that collects the most points per student will win a prize!

Tips for collecting and submitting Box Tops and Label UPC codes:

- Write your teacher’s name on any forms, Ziploc bags, or envelopes to be included in the classroom competition.
- Expired Box Tops cannot be redeemed, so be sure to check the expiration dates.
- The Labels for Education program will be discontinued after this year. Campbell’s Soup and Pepperidge Farm Labels must include the Labels for Education logo and the entire UPC code to be counted.
- If you use a collection form, Box Tops or Labels should be placed only in the designated spaces (please don’t add extras) and attached with glue or tape (not staples).
- Incomplete forms are fine – we’ll finish them off for you.
