The purpose of this program is to provide an opportunity for students to use their creative talents by expressing themselves through their own original works in one of these categories:

- Literature -- works of fiction, nonfiction, poetry, prose, drama, short stories and lyrics.
- Music Composition -- original musical composition, with or without words.
- **Photography** -- color or black and white prints, including techniques: photogram, retouched, montage, sandwich and multiple exposure. NOT TO EXCEED 18" x 24"
- Visual Arts -- drawing, painting in tempera, oil, acrylic, watercolor & t-shirt paints, computer
 generated art, two-dimensional collage, printmaking, needlework & leather tooling. DO NOT
 USE CANVAS STRETCHED OVER WOOD FRAMES. NOT TO EXCEED 18" x 24" AND
 NOT THICKER THAN 3/8".
- **Film/Video** -- original works, with or without sound, of animation, narrative, documentary, experimental or music video/film.
- Choreography/Dance -- originally choreographed dance composition.
